Learn French in small groups

You learn French to understand and communicate in your daily life but also at the "Campus des Métiers" and in the company where you'll have your work experience.

Our school provides ideal learning conditions and the maximum number of students per group is 8 (up to 10 in the summer months June to September). We can thus offer personalised support and a more active participation from each student.

A placement test establishes the level of writing and listening/speaking skills of each student and enables us to build up our groups. At "Tours Langues", we try to find the right balance between practice and theory.

Morning lessons are based on a progressive approach of the language: morning courses focus on grammar, listening and writing.

Afternoon lessons emphasize more interactive communication in French, civilisation and vocabulary.

Interactive education

Friday afternoon is kept free for cultural and/or sports activities: excursions, visits of castle in the Loire Valley, sports, tasting workshops... with the teachers.

Because "Tours Langues" has chosen an inter-cultural approach, part of the teaching occurs outside the school walls. Students regularly have the opportunity of discovering the current or historical facets of the town. Touraine is also a very touristic region: among other possibilities on offer, the châteaux are an essential part of the "Tours Langues" inter-cultural and educational programme.
